
COVID-19 Vaccine Side Effects

Side effects are <u>normal</u> and are a sign that your body is building immunity. Not everyone will have side effects. If you don't experience side effects, the vaccine is still working.





The vaccine's side effects are typically mild & only last a few days. Side effects might include sore arm, headache, fever, chills, fatigue, or nausea.

The known risks of getting sick with COVID-19 (severe or long-term illness or death) outweigh the risk of mild side effects from the vaccine. The vaccine won't just prevent deaths, it will reduce hospitalizations and <u>help us get back to normal</u>.
