## Partner vs. Friend

Partners enter an agreement with Science for Georgia.

Friends do not enter an agreement – they may be disallowed by law or by policy from entering into agreements or obligations. If you are a government organization, for example, Friend is the choice for you. In this case no endorsement or agreement is made or implied.

Otherwise, partners and friends function very similarly. A large partner network benefits us all, so we want everyone to join the conversation even if they cannot enter into agreements.

- You will be able to advertise your events and announcements through our:

- You will gain access to our Partner & Friend Listserv Email
- Your organization logo, linked to your organization website, will appear on our site with other partners and friends
- Upon request you may receive introductions to people and organizations within our network

## What We Ask of our Partners & Friends

- Periodically advertise Science for Georgia events and announcements to your communities
- Periodically advertise our partners & friends' events and announcements to your communities
- Attend one or more of our in-person or virtual networking events throughout the year
- Follow our social media accounts
- Respond to requests for introductions to people or organizations within your network
- Use our Listserv, when appropriate, to communicate:
  - o Events
  - o Advocacy opportunities
  - o Employment opportunities
  - o Volunteer opportunities
  - o Collaborative opportunities
  - o General questions
  - o Other non-fundraising announcements and asks

### We will NOT ask for:

- Monetary contributions or dues
- Participation in fundraising campaigns outside cohosted events

## **Values & Ethics**

Science for Georgia has a Statement of Mission, Ethics, and Responsibilities that we hold ourselves to. We expect similar behavior from our partners.

## **Indemnification & Liability**

Each party agrees to indemnify, defend, and hold harmless the other party their affiliates, employees, and agents from and against any loss, cost, or damage of any kind (including reasonable outside attorneys' fees) to the extent arising out of its breach of this Agreement, and/or its negligence or willful misconduct. Limitation of Liability. In no event will either party be liable for any consequential, indirect, exemplary, special, or incidental damages arising from or relating to this Agreement

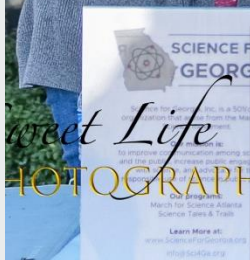
## **Partner & Friend Termination**
