

How to Use



Smell My City is an app that is designed to enable individuals to report smell-based issues in their local area. It was developed by engineers at Carnegie Mellon University.

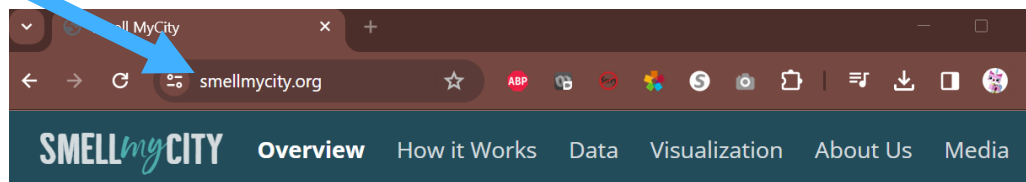
Science for Georgia will be analyzing this data to understand where and when issues may be occurring in your neighborhood.

Step One: Download the App

1. Go to <https://smellmycity.org/> or follow the QR code at right.
2. Use the **download** links to go to the app store. Download and install Smell My City.



Smell, Submit, Share!



Smell MyCity is a smartphone app designed to crowdsource reports of pollution odors travelling through our cities. All smell reports submitted through the app are [visible on our map](#), and this information is publicly available through our website (smellmycity.org). Local residents, organizations and regulators can use smell report data to help track down potential sources of pollution in their neighborhood.

Step Two: Report Smells!

When you smell something “not right” in your neighborhood.

Remember that anything you report is publicly available – so don’t enter your name or phone number or identifying information.

1. Open the App
2. Rate how the air smells. 1 is great, 5 is the worst.
3. Describe how the air smells. This is optional – but this helps us to identify what the source of the odor might be.
4. List symptoms that you experience. This is optional – but your eyes are watering, or you are coughing or you get a headache or your stomach hurts – we want to know.
5. Enter any additional information (optional).
6. Scroll down and Submit Smell Report
