- The purpose of the General Assembly is to **make laws**.
- 236 members serve two-year terms
- Members directly **elected by constituents** of their district.



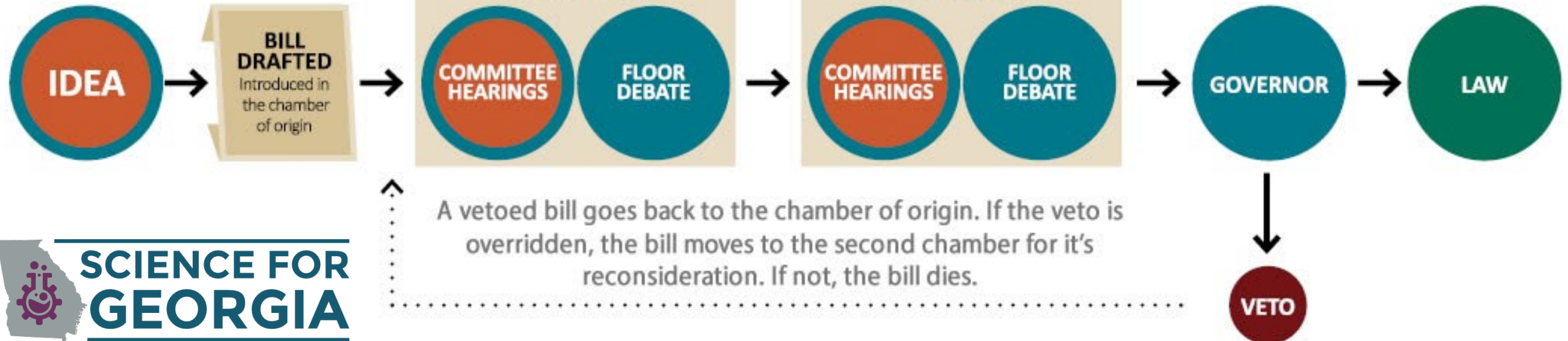
General Assembly:

Be Identified	Be Concise	Be Clear	Be Personal	Be Passionate	Be Respectful
Name + Zip Code + Relevant qualification.	Clear yes/no stand on issue.	One issue per contact. Three paragraphs max.	Story about relevance to you.	Show you care.	Don't threaten or scream.
