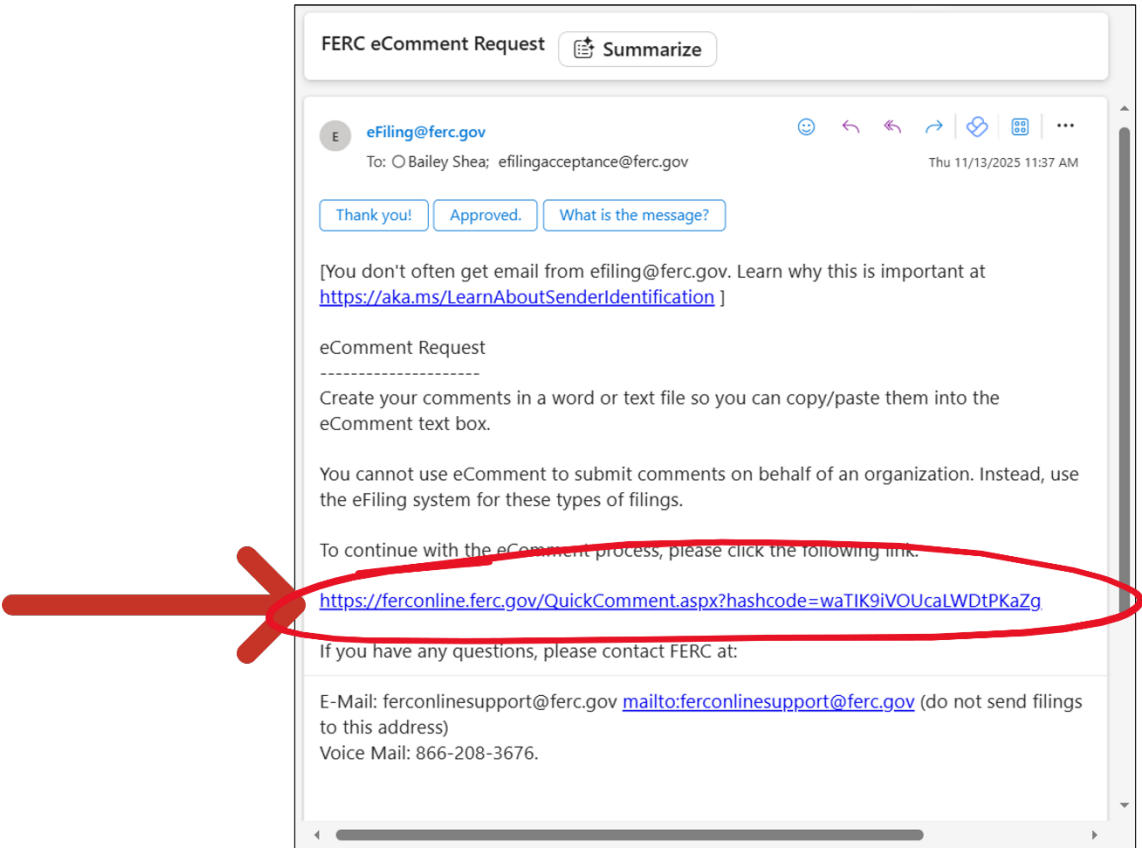

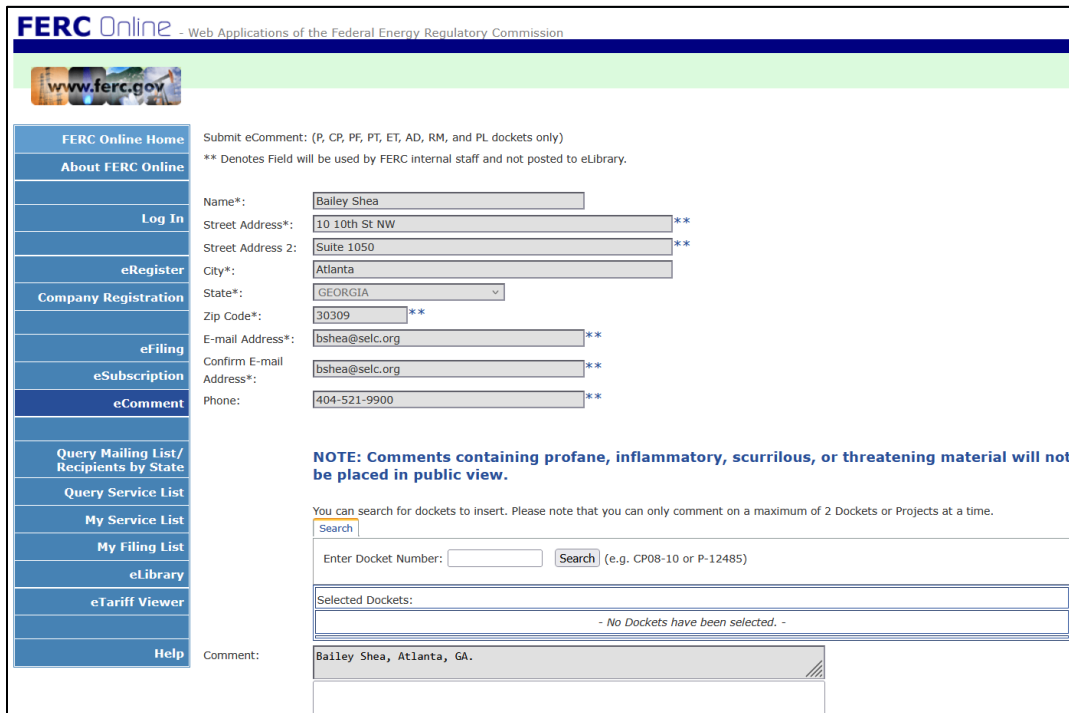
5. Access your email.
